

Outstanding Service Award – Member/Friend

Purpose

To recognize current CATFACS/CACTE members who have made the highest meritorious contributions to family and consumer sciences/career-technical education through active involvement in the professional organization of the Colorado Association Teachers of Family and Consumer Sciences and/or CACTE.

OR

To recognize an individual or agency outside the field of education that has contributed outstanding service and dedication in the promotion of family and consumer sciences education in Colorado and to the Colorado Association Teachers of Family and Consumer Sciences.

Eligibility

This award is given to individuals who are currently in the field of FCS/career-technical education. Individuals who have held key division, state and/or national professional offices or committee appointments and are current members of the association will be considered for this award. OR Individuals/agencies who have provided outstanding service and dedication to FCS/CATFACS.

Application Procedures

All nominations must be active member(s) and be endorsed by the division.

Complete and attach the CATFACS Nomination Cover Form and provide a written response which includes all the following support information in no more than 3 pages:

- A list of educational background and degrees.
- A list of offices held, committee membership and contributions in local and division (CATFACS) associations.
- A list of offices held, committee membership and contributions in CACTE – if any
- A list of offices held, committee membership and contributions in ACTE – if any
- Why you feel the nominee should receive this award.
- Letters of support. Letters should be one page in length. Suggested endorsers might include: political leaders, professional association leaders, business and industrial leaders, educational leaders, civic leaders, parents and students.

The CATFACS Service Award winner may be nominated to compete at the state level for the CACTE Outstanding Service Award. Individuals who will be competitive at the state level are those who have held offices or made significant contributions to the CACTE organization. If nominated, the nominee may be asked to provide additional information (additional letters of recommendation, picture, expanded professional activities, etc.) so a competitive packet may be submitted.
